Recycling

Our congregation is committed to caring for the Earth by reducing waste and unnecessary use of plastic, especially single-use items like plastic tablecloths and water bottles. Please help by recycling appropriately whenever you are in the church building and by reducing your use of plastic when possible. Use drinking fountains or reusable water bottles, and help clean tables so we can avoid using plastic table covers.

What Can Be Recycled?

Paper and cardboard

Plastic (clean bottles, cups, and containers)

Cans (both soda cans and food cans)

Glass

Styrofoam (must be sorted and clean, and put in separate bin)

Where Does it Belong?

All recycling goes in the blue bins marked for recycling. It must be free of food and other non-recyclable material.

Styrofoam goes in one of the specially marked boxes for Styrofoam.

Trash goes in the black or gray trash bins.
